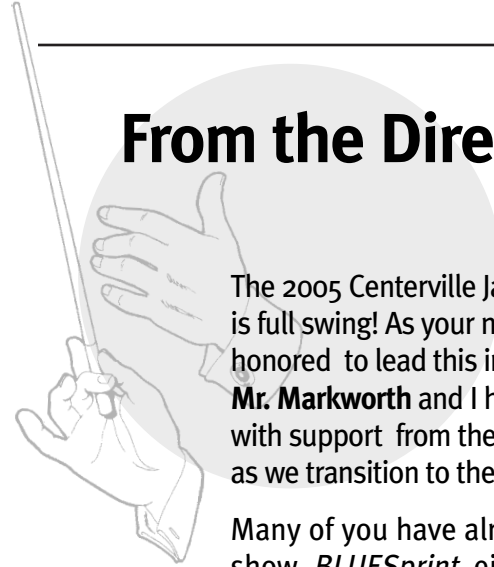

## 2005 Photo Season [chsbandphotos.org](http://chsbandphotos.org)


Well, based on the sunburn on my neck, the 2005 Photo Season has begun. This message is mostly for the new folks, but certainly applies to all of us. **Steve Matmuller** and I will again be taking "official" photos this season. Believe me, we enjoy it more than any of you do. It is a wonderful experience to see all the kids faces shining during performance and practice. We may not know much about the show, but we get to see a priceless view of the season. **Here are a few details worth mentioning about band photos:**

 For those not already aware, we have gone **completely digital**. From time to time we may post some hard copies, but basically, **all images are now available on the web**. It saves the boosters a nice chunk of change each season. **Truly ever dime we save, goes back the kids and the band program.**

 We take a **LOT of pictures**. Even if you do not intend to order any reprints, feel free to look at them. Do not fall behind or you may never catch up. Last season Steve and I took well **over 1500 pictures**, I suspect that will increase this year.


 We use a company called **Shutterfly** to produce image orders. They consistently **rank #1 in several quality ratings**. They are **cost effective**. We also **get a portion on the profits back from them** so it works well for the Band.


 If you are new to the photo web site, there is a link to "**Before You Order Images, Click Here.**" This is a document that helps to **explain how to order images**.


 We do **offer a set of CD's at the end of each season** if you want to buy all the images at once and then have them reproduced. Just **a word of caution, the disks have all the images, more than 1500**. It takes a lot to wade through them. I can also tell you that a couple of folks have tried to take the entire disk to a machine and produce them direct from there. It does not work, **there are too many images on the disk for most systems.**

One other thing to consider, you can get prints a little cheaper if you look, but you really won't save that much. I find that **using Shutterfly is much easier**. **Delivery takes about five days**. You can also expedite shipping if you need to. **They typically have them on the road within 24 hours.**

 We are also planning a couple of fun additions for you this year. Look for the **end of season collages** that will be available for purchase. They are fun and turn out very nicely.

 We try and post pictures after each event, and each day of band camp.

 The band camp images are fun instant confirmation that your son or daughter has survived the day. As long as the images are posted, it is also an acknowledgement that the photographer survived the night before. **We do not always post football game photos after each game. We try much harder to get the "events" up as quickly as possible. The latest images are always at the top of the list on the web page.**

 Don't ever feel like you can't take your own photos. There are certainly times that we get better access than the rest of you, but you are always welcome to take photos as far as Steve and I are concerned. There are **many times you are not allowed to use flash photography**. Call me or e-mail if you have any questions. Come see us at [chsbandphotos.org](http://chsbandphotos.org)!

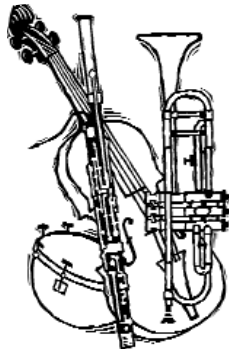

Due to your overwhelming response the **Massillon Regionals Parent Bus is full!** The Parent Bus is headed to:

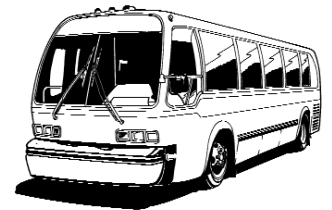
**2005 BOA Massillon Regional Championships**
