

Centerville City Schools and Ohio State Law regulations state that any student taking medication at the school and any activity, event, or program sponsored by or in which the student's school is a participant must have written permission from a doctor and parent.

Your student may carry and self administer specific medications which are **Epi-pen, Benadryl, Insulin, Diabetic supplies and multi-dose inhalers** with parent and physician authorization only.

- *Epi-Pens and multi-dose inhalers now require specific Medication Forms to be signed by parent and physician.*
- *For Epi Pens the Emergency Allergy Plan/Epinephrine Administration Authorization Form must be completed.* This form is two pages with a Parent section and a Medication Order to be signed by the physician.
- *The Authorization for Administration of Inhaled Asthma Medication must be completed for multi-dose inhalers.* This is a two page form with a Parent section and a Medication Order to be signed by the physician.
- All other medications, including over the counter medications require a Permission to Dispense Medication Form signed by Parent and Physician.
